

## Recommended Organizational Practices Adult-Use Stream

The following CAMCD Standards are designated as Recommended Organizational Practices (ROP's) and are recommended for all CAMCD Adult Use members:

- 1. Operate According to Standard Business Practices**  
Register your business, receive your GST number, and conduct your finances as a legitimate business (i.e. paying taxes, payroll remittances, and submitting year ends).
- 2. Age of Member**  
The business accepts members who have reached the age of majority in their province or territory.
- 3. Verification of Identification**  
The business verifies the age/ identity of the consumer prior to providing services in accordance with any applicable provincial server training program (i.e. "Serving it Right" in British Columbia).
- 4. Dispensing Area**  
The business ensures cannabis and cannabis products are dispensed in a clean environment.
- 5. Handling**  
The business ensures cannabis and cannabis products are handled in a sanitary and careful manner when dispensed.
- 6. Health and Safety Regulations**  
The business complies with all applicable municipal, provincial/territorial, and federal health and safety requirements.
- 7. Infection Control**  
The business abides by universal precautions for infection control.
- 8. Quality Control**  
The business engages in strict quality control measures to assess quality and identify problems regarding raw cannabis and other cannabis products it dispenses, and see tested products when possible.

9. Emergency Preparedness

Staff are trained and prepared to respond to health, security, fire, natural disasters and other emergencies.

10. Safe Conduct

Staff are trained and prepared to respond to incidents that have the potential to affect the health and safety of patients, personnel and the community.

11. Security Systems

The business ensures adequate security measures for all dispensing locations and production facilities.

12. Management of Sensitive Information

The business keeps strict control over information that could affect the safety and security of patients, personnel and the community.

13. Federal, Provincial/Territorial and Municipal Regulations

Where applicable, the business is in compliance with all applicable municipal, provincial/territorial and federal regulations.
